Term & Conditions of Membership of TRSC

For All Training Members

- for 2010 season, must be born before 1 January, 2002;
- for new Training Members, they must meet the minimum skiing ability criteria as determined by the TSRC Head Coach and/or TSRC Club President or TSRC Club Captain;
- must have all Club Fees paid prior to the commencement of training;
- must read, understand and sign the Club's Code of Conduct;
- must abide by the Club's Uniform Policy.

For 14 & Under Training Members

- must use best endeavours to compete in TSRC Cup, and National Children Championships series races.

For FIS Training Members

- must use best endeavours to compete in TSRC Cup and National FIS Championships at Thredbo.

For each Parent of a Training Member(s):

- make themselves available to assist the Club run skiing races on the Thredbo mountain – you will be rostered onto certain race days to undertake a specific task;
- complete the Child Protection (Prohibited Employment) Act 1998 declaration;
- counter sign each Training Member's Code of Conduct form and ensure that your child adheres to the Club's Code of Conduct;
- ensure that your child adheres to the Club's Uniform Policy;
- if you have a problem or an issue that you approach either the Club President, club Captain or Head Coach (in the first instance) to discuss. Such discussion should take place in either the administrative office (at the end of the clubrooms) or outside the clubrooms but never in the clubrooms in front of Training Members.
